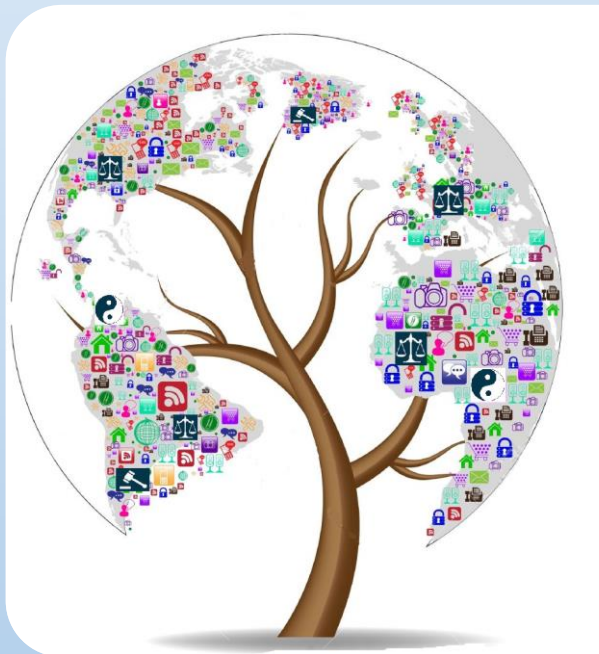

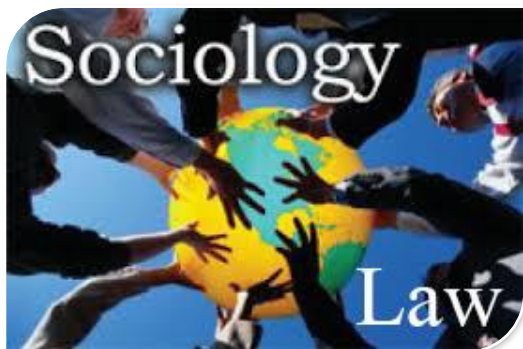
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1. COMMON DESCRIPTION OF THE FACULTY

Faculty of Sociology and Law (FSL) offers training at one of the most famous and rating world universities (according to the international ratings QS and Webometrics).

3. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

Levels of higher education. Training of students at FSP is carried out at three levels of higher education.

At the first level (bachelor, I-IV courses) students acquire knowledge in fundamental and special disciplines. In the fourth year, they defend their bachelor's theses and receive a bachelor's degree.



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At the second level (master's degree, I-II courses) students undergo special training and acquire relevant practical skills. Applicants defend master's theses, they are awarded a master's degree.

Third, educational and scientific level (graduate school, I-IV courses). Applicants prepare and defend dissertations, they are awarded the educational qualification of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD).

Terms of training: bachelor - 4 years; master's degree (educational-professional program) - 1.5 years; PhD - 4 years.

Specialists are trained on a full-time and part-time basis.

For this reason, an important task of the Department and the Centre was to provide training not only students of bachelor's and master's level of higher education in the field of information law but also the future teachers of information and legal disciplines.

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Along with fundamental legal disciplines, students gain in-depth knowledge of legal regulation of commercial and other economic activities, corporate relations, management and foreign economic activity, securities market, financial and banking law, legal issues of taxation, contract law. They also gain skills in drafting business contracts, procedural documents in court cases, learn the basics of organization and implementation of legal practice.



Graduates work as lawyers, notaries, judges, prosecutors, legal advisers, arbitrators, state registrars, tax inspectors, law enforcement investigators, heads of legal and administrative departments, teachers of higher education institutions, law professionals, and managers with civil service.

5. Department of Psychology and Pedagogy is a university-wide department, which provides teaching the cycle of psychological disciplines for all students and postgraduates of the Igor Sikorsky KPI.



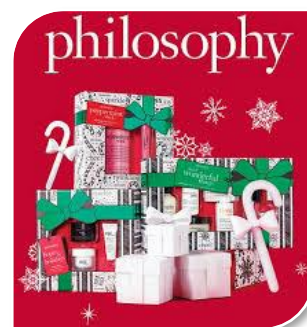
The department trains doctors of philosophy (PhD) in the specialty "Psychology" under the educational and scientific program "Psychology".

Teachers of the department research the following areas: integration of information and educational technologies in higher education; formation of psychological culture and professional ethics of the technical university teachers; psychological conditions of the development of the identity of the subjects of study: social, professional, gender; psychological determinants of optimization of business communications; problems of the industrial, institutional, economic psychology; active socio-psychological training: art therapy, family therapy.

6. Department of Philosophy trains doctors of philosophy (PhD) in the specialty "Philosophy" under the educational-scientific program "Philosophy".

Besides, teachers of the department teach courses in philosophy, ethics, aesthetics, religion, and the logic for bachelor training level at all faculties of the Igor Sikorsky KPI.

Specialists of the department hold courses "Basic scientific research" and "Philosophical problems of scientific knowledge." In



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addition, graduate students of all the faculties of the university are trained to pass doctoral examinations in philosophy.

7. Department of History trains doctors of philosophy (PhD) in the specialty "History and Archeology" under the educational and scientific program "History".

The department unites a highly qualified team of creative workers who provide teaching of basic and special disciplines of historical profile at all without exception, the faculties of Igor Sikorsky KPI. The strategic tasks of the department are determined by the needs of solving urgent problems of humanization of higher technical education, improving the quality of training, and expanding the horizons of future technical specialists.

4. TRAINING AND LABORATORY BASE

To improve the educational process **FSL** is provided by the following premises and laboratories:

- Research Center for Applied Sociology;
- Laboratory for Forensic Research;
- Legal Clinic;
- Scientific-Practical Center for Social Work;
- Scientific-Methodical Center for System Analysis and Statistics;
- Laboratory of Aesthetics and Design;
- Training Laboratory of Culturological Disciplines;
- Laboratory for Social Research.

Laboratory of Technical Aesthetics and Design

operates since 2006. Basic principles remain unchanged: aesthetic taste, search for beauty, harmony, and perfection, professionalism. Today the doors of the Laboratory are open to all undergraduate and graduate students wishing to study design, to express themselves in this area and be useful to faculty and university, to deepen their knowledge and skills, gain work experience in design.

Legal Clinic «DEFENDO» operates at the faculty since 2011. The basis of the legal clinic is to combine the interests of citizens in need of legal assistance, unable to pay for a

Research Centre of Applied Sociology SOCIOPLUS engaged in research since



2002, is the base of the study, production, and pre-diploma practice for students of a specialty "Sociology". During the internship, students are involved in a sociological case study of a full cycle. Centre SOCIOPLUS has at its disposal a focus group room where students can do their research.

International Centre for Business Ethics works closely with the Wrocław University of Technology, carries out scientific activities in international conferencing. Based on the center, students can participate in training, business games, and other kinds of activities to develop their business skills.

Educational and Research Center for Information Law and Legal Issues of Information Technology was established in cooperation with the Research Institute of Computer Science and Law of the National Academy of Legal Sciences of Ukraine.

The aim of the Centre is the implementation of fundamental research on the problems of legal regulation of information relations, thereby ensuring the educational process by relevant didactic materials, as well as the implementation of scientific expertise of draft legal acts on the regulation of these relations.

5. RESEARCH ACTIVITY

Department of Theory and Practice of Management

Teachers of the department carry out two initiative research topics:

- Social engineering as a factor of sustainable development of society;
- The impact of e-governance on social transformation.

Department of Philosophy

Fundamental research on the most important issues of the development of scientific, technical, socio-economic, socio-political, the human capacity for Ukraine's competitiveness and sustainable development of society and the state

Department of History

In the framework of the scientific theme "Historical and cultural heritage of Ukraine: sources and methodology of research" the following individual research projects are carried out: Ethno-national and ethnocultural processes on the territory of Ukraine; Church and the spiritual culture of Ukraine; Genesis of the educational systems in



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Ukraine; Historical development of the scientific and technical potential of Ukraine; Print media of Ukraine (history and modernity); Bibliographistics (the study of the life and activity of prominent public figures, scientists, culture, art, and education figures); History of the Igor Sikorsky KPI, and others.

Department of Psychology and Pedagogy

Integration of information and educational technologies in higher education; Formation of psychological culture and professional ethics of Technical University teachers; Psychological conditions of the development of the subjects of study identity: social, professional, gender; Psychological determinants of optimization of business communications; Problems of the industrial, institutional, and economic psychology; An active social and psychological training.

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6. INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS AND COLLABORATION

An important component of the **FSL** operation is an international activity that is carried out through the holding of international seminars and conferences, "round tables" and press clubs, organizations of innovative research projects and participation in these projects, development of international relations with scientists from various countries.

Students participate in academic mobility program Erasmus.

The faculty collaborates with universities in Germany, Poland, and the Czech Republic in matters of:

- Support the exchange of teachers;
- Student mobility programs to advance language skills and professional competence;
- Carrying out joint scientific consultations, exchange by specialized publications;
- Exchange of experience and information on the qualifications;
- Mutual recognition of diplomas and recommendations based on international agreements;
- The possibility of joint scientific publications;
- Development of joint educational and research projects.

Honorary guest speakers, active members of international conferences, roundtables, and symposia at the faculty were outstanding foreign scientists and science figures of Budapest University, University of Poznan, University of Latvia, University of Toronto, Georgian-American University, University of Liège, University of Paris 8, and New York University London.
