



International Scientific and Technical Cooperation and Entrepreneurship 4.0

Thursday, February 24, 2022 3:00 - 5:00 pm (Beijing Time)

This program presents the socio-economic changes in society under the influence of the quarantine restrictions of 2020-2021. The influence of Industry 4.0 on the reasons and forms of organization of quarantine restrictions at the international level is revealed. This webinar explains the need to change the economic model of organizing production using Industry 4.0 technologies. The possibilities of financing the necessary changes and assessing their effectiveness have been analyzed.

Discussion includes the theoretical aspects of competition under Industry 4.0 conditions. It explains the connection between theories of competition and economic harmonies and suggests a system view on their mutual application. Highlights include the theoretical aspects of Product Development 4.0 and the influence of global problems of Humanity (such as COVID-19) which changes the approach to Product Development.
