


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1. COMMON DESCRIPTION OF THE FACULTY

Faculty of Sociology and Law (FSL) offers training at one of the most famous and rating world universities (according to the international ratings QS and Webometrics).



Modern methods of teaching, close ties with employers, training of the best students in the employer's firms, the practice of international student exchanges, meetings, and communication with well-known sociologists and lawyers from Poland, USA, Germany, and the CIS countries - these are just some of the benefits of an education at the faculty.

The faculty consists of leading experts in sociology, political science, law, and public administration. They have great experience in research, teaching, and practice both in Ukraine and abroad.

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3. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

Levels of higher education. Training of students at FSP is carried out at three levels of higher education.

At the first level (bachelor, I-IV courses) students acquire knowledge in fundamental and special disciplines. In the fourth year, they defend their bachelor's theses and receive a bachelor's degree.

At the second level (master's degree, I-II courses) students undergo special training and acquire relevant practical skills. Applicants who defend master's theses are awarded a master's degree.

Third, educational and scientific level (graduate school, I-IV courses). Applicants prepare and defend dissertations, they are awarded the educational qualification of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.).

Terms of training: bachelor - 4 years; master's degree (educational-professional program) - 1.5 years; Ph.D. - 4 years.

Specialists are trained on a full-time and part-time basis.

Along with fundamental legal disciplines, students gain in-depth knowledge of legal regulation of commercial and other economic activities, corporate relations, management, foreign economic activity, securities market, financial and banking law, legal issues of taxation, and contract law. They also gain skills in drafting business contracts, and procedural documents in court cases, and learn the basics of organization and implementation of legal practice.



Graduates work as lawyers, notaries, judges, prosecutors, legal advisers, arbitrators, state registrars, tax inspectors, law enforcement investigators, heads of legal and administrative departments, teachers of higher education institutions, law professionals, and managers with civil service.

5. Department of Psychology and Pedagogy is a university-wide department, which provides teaching the cycle of psychological disciplines for all students and postgraduates of the Igor Sikorsky KPI.



Teachers of the department teach courses in philosophy, ethics, aesthetics, religion, and the logic for bachelor training level at all faculties of the Igor Sikorsky KPI.

Specialists of the department hold courses "Basic scientific research" and "Philosophical problems of scientific knowledge." In



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addition, graduate students of all the faculties of the university are trained to pass doctoral examinations in philosophy.

7. Department of History trains doctors of philosophy (Ph.D.) in the specialty **032** "History and Archeology" under the educational and scientific program "History".

The department unites a highly qualified team of creative workers who provide teaching of basic and special disciplines of historical profile at all without exception, the faculties of Igor Sikorsky KPI. The strategic tasks of the department are determined by the need of solving urgent problems of humanization of higher technical education, improving the quality of training, and expanding the horizons of future technical specialists.

4. TRAINING AND LABORATORY BASE

The FSP has about 40 comfortable classrooms, including computer labs and lecture halls. Smart boards and multimedia projectors are available in the classrooms. All departments of the faculty are equipped with the necessary equipment (computers, printers, scanners, photocopiers, risographs).

The following departments support the educational process:

The Laboratory of Technical Aesthetics and Design has been operating since 2006.

The Legal Clinic has been operating as part of the Faculty of Sociology and Law of Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute since 2011.

The basis of the legal clinic's activities is a combination of the interests of citizens in need of legal assistance who are unable to pay for legal services and students interested in gaining practical skills that will help them find employment and a career.

Laboratory of Business Ethics Development works closely with the Wrocław University of Technology and carries out scientific activities in international conferencing. Based on the center, students can participate in training, business games, and other kinds of activities to develop their business skills.

Educational and Research Laboratory for Information Law and Legal Issues of Information Technology was established in cooperation with the Research Institute of Computer Science and Law of the National Academy of Legal Sciences of Ukraine.



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The aim of the Centre is the implementation of fundamental research on the problems of legal regulation of information relations, thereby ensuring the educational process by relevant didactic materials, as well as the implementation of scientific expertise of draft legal acts on the regulation of these relations.

The educational process is supported by the following units of the faculty:

The Laboratory of Technical Aesthetics and Design has been operating since 2006.

The Educational and Practical Laboratory of Information Law and Legal Issues of Information Technologies was established jointly with the Research Institute of Informatics and Law of the National Academy of Legal Sciences of Ukraine.

The purpose of the Laboratory is to conduct fundamental research on the problems of legal regulation of information relations, to provide the educational process with relevant didactic material, and to conduct scientific examinations of draft legal acts regulating these relations.
